MINIMUM POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Hold a current State of Ohio OPOTA certification as a Peace Officer
- Legally able to work within the U.S.
- Possess a valid Ohio Driver License with satisfactory driving record
- Minimum High School Diploma or equivalent, college preferred
- Knowledge of current law enforcement principles, procedures, and techniques
- Ability to perform work requiring good physical condition, communicate effectively orally and in writing, establish and maintain effective working relationships with the public, peers and supervisors, exercise sound judgment and perform during stressful situations
- Ability to pass a thorough background investigation, physical, and drug screen

- Part Time Patrol Officers operate under a collective bargaining agreement with OPBA
